

Guidelines and Rules

<u>Entry Form Deadline</u>: Friday, January 31st <u>Science Fair:</u> Saturday, Feb 22, 8:30am-12pm (Opens at 8am, set up to be done by 8:15am)

Participation and Groups: Projects can be worked on and presented by an individual or groups of 2-3, <u>all members must be in the same grade</u>. Only 1 entry form needs to be submitted per group.

Safety Rules: No hazardous chemicals, open flame, torches or burners may be used. Cultures of mold and bacteria must be thoroughly sealed. Food and animals are not permitted at the fair. All projects must be testable and safe. <u>No pre-made kits will be used.</u>

Projects: Once entry is submitted, you will receive an email that will confirm project approval. Then students can begin working on their projects and write up their results and a conclusion.

Science Fair: All participants must have their project displayed on a tri-fold board, you can include photos or drawings. You must include how you used the scientific method either on your poster or in your presentation. The space on the table will be limited. The display must stand by itself. You will not have access to electricity. If you need assistance with the purchase of materials for the display, please reach out directly to the Ehrman Crest PTO via email.

Other Info: The science fair panel of judges will be walking around during the fair and will expect the participants to explain the project. You may be asked specific questions from the judges. If participating in a group project all members must answer questions.

You are going to be the teacher at the science fair so learn all you can about your topic and have fun!!

Attendance: You must be able to attend the entire time in order to be eligible to win. You will be able to walk around and look at others projects after judging is over around 11am (depending on the amount of participants)
